## Conditions of Entry

1. All exhibits must be the signed original work of the exhibitor and **MUST BE FOR SALE**. 'Work' is any art completed in styles including, but not limited to: oil, acrylic, water colour, gouache, pastel, mixed media, pencil, pen & ink, charcoal or crayon.
2. Work previously exhibited will not be accepted.
3. Complementary pairs are considered as one exhibit and cannot be sold separately. Pairs will be hung side by side.
4. Exhibits will be received at Strathdon Community, 17 Jolimont Road, Forest Hill (enter via Commemorative Pathway) on **Tuesday 21 March 2017, 9am – 6pm**.
5. Exhibits will be displayed at the Committee's discretion. We endeavour to hang/display all entered exhibits, depending on the space available. The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry. Wet paintings will not be accepted. A NO REFUND policy applies.
6. No work shall have any side greater than 1.5 metres.
7. Works are to be framed or canvas on frame, and fitted with picture wire or cord and suitably attached to the frame to a professional standard. 'Screw eyes' or 'eye hooks', are **not acceptable** as they can damage other works.
8. Paintings must be clearly labelled on the back (top left hand corner) with Title, Artist's Name and Retail Selling Price. Exhibit ID slips are available.
9. **Miniatures criteria:** A piece of miniature art is capable of being held in the palm of the hand and the painted area does not exceed 100 sq.cm. (ie. 10 x 10cm); overall frame size not to exceed 750 sq.cm (25 x 30cm); all mediums. Portraits should not exceed 3.5cm from chin to top of head, and in all paintings the spirit of miniaturisation should be maintained.
10. The number of exhibits is limited to four (4) from any one artist.
11. All reasonable care will be taken of exhibits in our possession. Strathdon Community does not insure exhibits.
12. Strathdon Community shall retain a commission of 25% of the retail price of any exhibits sold as a result of the exhibition.
13. No artist will win more than one prize and the Judge's decisions are final.
14. Unsold exhibits must be collected from drop off point on **Sunday, 26 March from 4.30pm – 6pm**, otherwise, a late pick up fee of \$10 per exhibit will be charged. Phone Madelin on 0437 470 441.
15. Receipts or written authorisation must be shown by the collector to pick up works.
16. Any freight cost is to be paid by the artist.
17. Works not exhibited may be collected by prior arrangement during the show. Phone Madelin on 9276 5706 or 0437 470 441.
18. Payments for sales will be made by bank transfer. A request for bank account details will be sent to the artist so a deposit can be made within 21 days of the art exhibition.
